


About The Tsugaru Strait Area

The Tsugaru Strait Area consists of two land regions, Aomori Prefecture and the southern Hokkaido regions around Hakodate, and the Tsugaru Strait between them. This area has a long history of social exchange that developed into a unique culturally-rich region as early as the 10th or the 11th century. To further emphasize their interaction, the long and massive undersea "Seikan Tunnel" was unveiled in 1988. Moreover, the Hokkaido Shinkansen started operations in March 2016, allowing people to travel between the two areas in about 1 hour. The beautiful seasonal changes, variety of interesting places, delicious food, and exciting events make the Tsugaru Strait Area a definite must-go spot!


Valuable free pass information




JR East-South Hokkaido Rail Pass



This pass allows rides on the trains and designated buses in Hokkaido operated by JR Hokkaido. (Excluding Hokkaido Shinkansen)










About The

The Hokkaido Shinkansen uses the H5 Series trains. The designated maximum speed is 320km/h! The purple stripe along the middle of the train represents the beautiful lilacs, lupines, and lavender of Hokkaido.

Snowmobile on frozen Önuma Lake

From mid-January to the beginning of March, the ice on the lake becomes thick enough to ride snowmobiles over it. You can experience this for a limited period only in the northland. Imagine carving through the vast snowfields with majestic Mt. Komagatake in the background.

Lake Towada Winter Story Festival

An event held every winter in Aomori is gathering great attention. It offers a fantasy world with a gate of snow, snow sculptures, and the tunnel created with blue LED lights. The "Kamakura (igloo) Bar" offers drinks served in cups made of ice or apples.



ACCESS Shin Aomori Station ▶ Car (3 hours)

Frost Covered Trees in the Hakkoda Mountains.

The trees in the Hakkoda Mountains are covered with ice and snow in winter. Those beautifully frost covered trees are also called "Snow Monsters". Taking a ropeway and looking down on the Snow Monsters from above is one of the best experiences visitors can enjoy.
